Speaker Cable

Connection and Care

Congratulations for choosing this interconnect. Please observe the following notes on operation and maintenance for lasting joy and satisfaction with your cable:

1. Description

This speaker cable is made from (almost) completely natural materials. This is not a disadvantage - the word "natural" can be transferred directly to the sound. This is a foil cable, in that the two conductive elements are configured as metal foils which are very thin, but very wide, in order to have the necessary low electrical resistance. These two metal foils are arranged one above the other. Through this arrangement, the electromagnetic field can be very effectively transferred by the amplifier to the loudspeaker.

2. Unpacking

To become familiar with the product, I recommend you take the packing box into a large room to unpack it. You can twist the cable around the long axis and bend the thin side.




Avoid bending the wide side! Keep the original packaging in case you need to transport the cable at a later date.

3. Please note the following:

- **Under no circumstances use any detergent on the cable. A moistened cloth is permitted, if necessary, to clean the cable.**

- **Avoid stretching the cable and avoid using very sharp bending radii.**

- **Do not place objects on the cable. Move the cable around like a precision instrument. Lay loose it - it should NOT be connected in any tension.**



4. Burn in and direction of use

The cable needs at least 50 hours until the soundstage is created. Then it gets better but more slowly. The direction of the signal is shown on the label.

5. Care

Once or twice a year, the contact surfaces of the plugs should be cleaned with alcohol.
